Dear Chairman Dupray,

After a review of the Highway 50 Corridor regional fee concept and its proposed implementation in El Dorado County, the El Dorado Hills Chamber of Commerce requests that the Board of Supervisors endorse the program in concept.

The transportation problems in our county and throughout the Highway 50 Corridor into Sacramento have long been a concern of the El Dorado Hills Chamber. We have closely tracked and supported the work of the Highway 50 Corridor Mobility Partnership to identify needed road and transit improvements that would benefit our members and the entire western slope. We anticipate that those projects will have a significant positive impact on current and future congestion on and near Highway 50.

We understand that it will take significant private investment to move these projects forward.
